EnergySmart Grocer Rebate Reservation Terms and Conditions:

As used throughout this document, the term "Party" means Portland Energy Conservation, Inc. (PECI) and Customer, collectively referred to as the "Parties."

1. I understand that to be eligible for a rebate under the EnergySmart Grocer Program, I must be a Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) grocery store electric customer who pays Public Goods Charge with demand of 70 kW or greater.
2. I understand that unless a reservation has been confirmed in writing by the EnergySmart Grocer Program, rebates will be paid if and when funds become available.
3. I understand that this rebate is subject to change or disqualification if the actual installation differs from the quantities or measures listed above, if the measures do not meet the EnergySmart Grocer Program's Equipment Specifications, and/or if the rebate paperwork will not be submitted by the anticipated rebate paperwork submission date listed above.
4. I understand that if my project is expected to complete after the estimated completion date indicated above, I must notify the EnergySmart Grocer Program at least 15 business days before my estimated paperwork submission date. Projects that do not meet their estimated completion date may not receive a rebate.
5. I understand that this Application shall at all times be subject to changes or modifications by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) as it may from time to time direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.
6. I understand that the energy efficiency eligibility requirement for each product determines the rebate amount, and that the rebate amount cannot exceed the purchase cost.
7. I will allow, if requested, a representative from PG&E, the CPUC, PECI, or any authorized subcontractor reasonable access to my property to verify the installed product.
8. I understand that PECI is receiving funds from PG&E for this Project, but the Parties acknowledge and agree that PG&E shall not be liable to any Party for any losses or damages, including incidental or consequential damages, arising from or relating to this Application. PG&E makes no representation or warranty, and assumes no liability with respect to quality, safety, performance, or other aspect of any design, system or appliance installed pursuant to this Application, and expressly disclaims any such representation, warranty or liability. PG&E's and/or its consultant's review of the design, construction, operation or maintenance of the Project, Energy Efficiency Measures, or demand response measures does not constitute any representation as to the economic or technical feasibility, operational capability, or reliability of the Project measures.
9. I acknowledge and agree that I cannot receive rebate(s) for the same product, equipment or service from more than one California investor-owned utility or third party energy efficiency program offering rebate(s) for the same product, equipment, or service funded with CPUC Public Goods Charge funds.
10. If a tenant, I am responsible for obtaining the property owner's permission to install the measure(s) for which I am applying for a rebate payment. By signing this Application, I represent that I have obtained such permission.
11. I certify that the information on this application is true and correct. I have read and understand these Terms and Conditions and I agree to abide by those requirements. All customer information will be kept confidential and will not be distributed outside of the Program, participating contractors, PG&E and the CPUC.
12. Each Party shall indemnify the other for any losses or damages, except to extent that the losses or damages arise from a Party's sole negligence or willful misconduct.

ADDENDUM

THIS ADDENDUM TO THE EnergySmart Grocer Rebate Reservation Application is effective as of January 1, 2009 (Addendum). The purpose of this Addendum is to allow work to continue under certain 2006-2008 energy efficient programs until the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) makes a final decision on the 2009-2011 energy efficient Application.

1. On October 16, 2008 the CPUC issued a Bridge Funding Decision authorizing funding for work performed after December 31, 2008 and until the date which is no later than three months after the effective date of a

final decision by the CPUC on the 2009-2011 Application, or December 31, 2009, whichever occurs first (Bridge Funding Period).

2. For those projects under this Program which work may be done or completed after the Bridge Funding Period, any payments made to customers will be subject to CPUC approval and in accordance with the CPUC's final decision on the 2009-2011 Application.
3. The remaining terms of the EnergySmart Grocer Rebate Reservation Application, as amended, restated, supplemented or modified under this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect for such Bridge Funding Period. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of the EnergySmart Grocer Rebate Reservation Application and the terms of this Addendum, the terms of this Addendum shall control.
